On February 24, 2004 General Motors announced Product Safety Recall 04002. The total number of vehicles involved is 1,047,175.

Due to the large number of vehicles involved and anticipated parts availability, this recall is being conducted in 3 phases. Phase 1 consisted of 1998-1999 model year vehicles and recall notification letters were mailed to these customers on March 1, 2004.

Phase 2 consists of 2000 model year vehicles and is being released today. These customers will receive recall notification letters within the next few days. A new Campaign Initiation Detail Report (CIDR) for these vehicles will be available to dealers in GM DealerWorld starting today.

Phase 3 of this recall will consist of 2001 model year vehicles and will be released when sufficient parts are available. You will be notified and a corresponding CIDR will be available when this occurs.
