Harley-Davidson Motor Company, Inc. has learned that the following XL, Dyna and Touring model motorcycles built between June 4, 2003 and August 22, 2003:

have a condition that could allow the tail light bulb to fall out of the socket, thereby rendering the tail light and the brake light inoperative, which could lead to a crash, causing the possibility of death or injury to the rider.

We have voluntarily declared this a defect related to motor vehicle safety (Campaign 0114) to allow us to formally recall all affected motorcycles. The remedy of this issue is to replace the Wagner (supplier) tail light bulb on the above noted vehicles with a Sylvania (supplier) bulb, which fits properly in the socket.

In the interest of the safety of our mutual customers and as required by law, you may sell but NOT DELIVER any affected motorcycles to your customers. A service bulletin outlining the repair and credit procedure, along with a list of affected VIN's will follow within two weeks.

In accordance with Federal regulations administrated by NHTSA, Harley-Davidson Motor Company, Inc. will provide notice to all owners of record of affected products with direction to bring the vehicle in for the recall service.
