DESCRIPTION:

F/CMVSS NONCOMPLIANCE RECALL #04056 - DATED: AUGUST 23, 2004

- General Motors has decided that certain 2004 model year Chevrolet Cavalier and Pontiac Sunfire vehicles fail to conform to Federal/Canada Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 209, Seat Belt Assemblies, and Standard 210, Seat Bel Assembly Anchorages. On some of these vehicles, the passenger-side rear safety belt may have been installed with an incorrect nut and bolt. In a severe crash, the upper seat belt anchorage may separate. The effectiveness of the seat belt could then be reduced and the occupant could receive greater injuries.
- Dealers are to inspect the safety belt anchorage, and if necessary, install a new nut and bolt.
- Refer to the F/CMVSS Noncompliance Recall Bulletin for further information.
