Based on information from the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) website, the media may report that General Motors will be announcing a safety recall involving certain 1999 Buick Century and Regal vehicles.

Some 1999 Buick *Century & Regal* passenger cars built in August 1998 – June 1999 may not conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 108, "Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment." Some of these vehicles do not meet the overhead sign illumination requirements of the standard. Testing indicated that, on certain vehicles, up to five of the eight photometric locations above the horizon that provide light for reading overhead signs are below the minimum candela requirements.

To correct this condition, Buick dealers will install low beam headlamp bulbs in both headlamp assemblies on the 213,839 suspect vehicles. These repairs will be performed at no cost to the customers.

GM is working with its suppliers to obtain the parts needed to correct this condition as quickly as possible. Based on the anticipated schedule, we plan to begin notifying customers about this recall beginning September 14, 2004.

Listed below are some anticipated questions and answers to assist in responding to customer inquiries.

Q1: What is the condition that prompted a safety recall?

A1: Some 1999 Buick Century & Regal passenger cars built in August 1998 – June 1999 may not conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 108, "Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment." Some of these vehicles do not meet the overhead sign illumination requirements of the standard.

Q2: What is the cause of the condition?

A2: Marginal variance in the optical form of the lens during manufacturing.

Q3: Is there reason for being concerned about this condition?

A3: The headlamps provide the required brightness to see down the road during nighttime driving.

- Q4: How would a vehicle owner realize the condition exists?
- A4: It is unlikely that an owner would notice a difference.
- Q5: What will GM do to correct this condition on the subject vehicles?
- A5: Buick dealers will install low beam headlamp bulbs in both headlamp assemblies. These repairs will be performed at no cost to the customers.
- Q6: Where were these vehicles built?
- A6: The vehicles involved in this recall were built at the General Motors assembly plant in Oshawa, Ontario.
- Q7: Have there been any reports of crashes or injuries related to this condition?
- A7: There have been no reports of crashes or injuries.
- Q8: Are parts at the dealers, and can customers bring in their vehicles for repair right away?
- A8: No. Customers will be notified of the recall the week of September 14, 2004.
- Q9: Why did it take so long to initiate this recall?
- A9: In early 2000, GM petitioned NHTSA to treat the non-compliance as inconsequential because the deviation from the requirement was not discernible to the naked eye and because vehicle meets the standard for illumination of the road. NHTSA denied the petition in July 2001. GM requested NHTSA to reconsider in September 2001. NHTSA denied exemption in January 2004.
- Q10: Are these vehicles safe to drive?
- A10: During nighttime driving, the 1999 Buick Century and Regal headlamps provide the required brightness for the customer to see down the road. The vehicles involved in this recall meet every other Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS).

- General Motors has decided that certain 1999 model year Buick Century and Regal vehicles fail to conform to Federal/Canada Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 108, Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment. Some of these vehicles do not meet the overhead sign illumination requirements in the Standard 108. Less illumination may reduce the ability of the driver to read overhead signs when driving at night.
- Dealers are to install new low beam headlamp bulbs in both headlamp assemblies.
