Blue Bird Body Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2003-2005 model year Blue Bird Ultra Low Floor transit buses manufactured from March 14, 2003 through July 02, 2004 equipped with Arvin-Meritor DX 195 air disc brakes.

The final remedy for the defect has not been determined at this time. In the meantime, the brake system will be inspected and new disc brake pads installed by Arvin-Meritor. Arvin-Meritor will contact affected dealers and owners to arrange a time to perform the interim inspection and modification.

If our records indicate affected units were delivered in your service area, a printout identifying affected units is enclosed. Dealers should verify correct owners and that complete shipping addresses are provided for each listed vehicle. If you have in your possession or have sold a vehicle that was purchased from another dealer that may be affected by this recall, please notify me at 478-822-2242.
