Subject: 2004 Xterra Tow Hitch Voluntary Recall Campaign

Attention - Dealer Principals and Service Managers

\*\*\*\*\* Campaign Announcement \*\*\*\*\*

Nissan is conducting a Voluntary Safety Recall Campalgn on 131 Model Year 2004 Nissan Xterra vehicles. On the affected vehicles, the Nissan accessory tow hitch attaching bolts may not have been tightened to the proper specification. If the tow hitch is being used, this condition could cause the tow hitch to loosen or separate from the vehicle, which could result in a crash.

To prevent this condition from occurring, Nissan will torque the tow hitch attaching bolts to the proper specification.

\*\*\*\*\* Dealer Inventory \*\*\*\*\*

Federal law requires that new vehicles in dealer inventory which are the subject of a safety recall must be corrected prior to delivery under a sale or lease. Failure to do so can result in civil penalties by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA).

Owner Notification letters will be mailed on January 3, 2005 to all affected owners.
