Please be advised MNAO has notified NHTSA of a possible defect related to the rear seat belts on approximately 115 2004 MAZDA6 vehicles.

NHTSA has also been notified of a possible defect related to the accelerator cable on certain 2002-2004 Tribute vehicles, representing approximately 121,000 subject vehicles

This is to notify you of an upcoming recall on certain 2004 MAZDA6 vehicles. You will receive detailed information the week of December 27.

Mazda will notify U.S. MAZDA6 owners by first class mail beginning December 27, 2004.

Mazda Motor Corporation has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2004 MAZDA6 vehicles produced from January 15, 2004 through March 3, 2004.

On certain 2004 MAZDA6 vehicles, the right and/or left rear seat belt(s) may not lock properly due to missing retaining pins on the housing. The seat belt retractor locking mechanism may malfunction, increasing the risk of death or serious injury to the rear seat passengers in the event of a crash. Passengers should not sit and child seats should not be used in the right or left rear seats until this defect has been corrected.

There is only a very small number of vehicles affected by this campaign (about 190 vehicles.) The owners of affected vehicles will be notified by first class mail beginning December 27, 2004.
