

OWNER'S LETTER

Dear Infiniti owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan Motor Company, Ltd. has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in some 2004 model year Infiniti Q45 and M45 vehicles.

Reason for Recall

The brake lamp switch in your vehicle may malfunction. If this occurs, the brake lamps will not illuminate when the brake is applied, which could result in a crash without warning.

What Infiniti Will Do

The brake lamp switch will be replaced. This free service should take about one hour to complete, but your Infiniti dealer may require your vehicle for a longer period of time based upon their work schedule, or parts availability.

What You Should Do

Contact your Infiniti dealer at your earliest convenience in order to arrange an appointment to have your vehicle repaired. Please bring this notice with you when you keep your service appointment. Instructions have been sent to your Infiniti dealer. If the dealer fails, or is unable to make the necessary repairs free of charge, you may contact an Infiniti representative toll free at (800) 662-6200. Federal regulations require that any vehicle lesser receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.
