2. Number of Vehicles Potentially Affected.

The number of vehicles potentially affected by this Service Campaign in the U.S. is approximately 121,500.


3. Program for Remedy.

All involved vehicles will be subject to the Service Campaign. Vehicle owners will receive a letter via first class mail. The letter will request that the owner of the vehicle take their vehicle to a Volvo retailer for inspection and remedy. The remedy is the same as the remedy for Volvo Recall No. 139 (NHTSA Recall No. 04V368.) The remedy is to inspect the vehicle's fuel tank for fuel seepage at the heat shield attachment points. The fuel tank will be replaced if any seepage is found. To prevent future occurrence of fuel seepage a bushing will be installed to each of the heat shield attachments on the fuel tank.
