
Dear Ms. Wallace:

Enclosed please find the Vehicle Safety Recall Quarterly Report Information sheet for the first quarter of 2006 for the above-referenced recall campaign involving certain 2000, 2001 and 2002 Challenger, CTS, Defender, Corporal, and General model buses that may develop cracks in the sub-floor frame crossmembers and/or floor risers.

Although the initial phase of the recall campaign had not yet been completed, NHTSA required Champion Bus to initiate a renotification campaign. This quarterly report is being filed in accordance with the follow-up notification procedures set forth in 49 CFR Part 577.10.
