Dear Mitsubishi Fuso Truck Owner:

This is a follow up to notices you should have received dated January 13, 2005 and March 8, 2006 regarding this Safety Recall.

Mitsubishi Fuso Truck of America, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in clamps securing fuel injection pipes on certain vehicles. On affected vehicles, the rubber portion of the fuel injection pipe clamps could deteriorate. Normal vehicle operation could cause the deteriorated clamp to loosen and drop. If this condition occurs in the area of the engine starter, a short circuit could occur if the clamp drops onto the starter terminal. This could prevent the engine from starting. In the worst case, excessive heat from a short circuit could cause a fire.

IMPORTANT! Sign and date this reply, as permanent changes are not valid without your signature.

The outer portion of the fuel injection pipe clamps and all attaching hardware will be replaced. Adhesive will be applied to the attaching hardware to prevent the clamps from loosening. In addition, the starter motor will be inspected to insure the presence of a protective rubber cap that would prevent a short circuit. If not present, a cap will be installed. A new label will be affixed to the vehicle cautioning against dropping clamps/bolts during future fuel injection pump and/or fuel line repair work. The procedure will be completed at no cost to you when performed by an Authorized Dealer or Parts and Service Center. The scheduled time for repair is approximately 2.4 hours for standard cab trucks, and 3.1 hours for crew cab trucks.

Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days. If you are the lessor of the above referenced vehicle, please forward this notification immediately.

Note: If you have incurred costs to obtain a remedy for the problem addressed in this recall prior to initial notification, please present the paid invoice to an Authorized Mitsubishi Fuso Dealer or Parts and Service Center. The Dealer/Parts & Service Center will submit a warranty claim to MFTA on your behalf. Reimbursement of these costs should be expected within 30 days of warranty claim submittal.

We at MFTA regret any inconvenience this situation may cause you. However, your safety and continued satisfaction with our product are most important to us.
