ON CERTAIN MOTORHOMES, THE 120-VOLT SHORE POWER CORD WAS WIRED WITHOUT A CIRCUIT PROTECTION DEVICE.

Consequence:
THIS COULD CAUSE A FIRE.

Remedy:
DEALERS WILL INSPECT AND REWIRE THE 120-VOLT SHORE POWER CORD AND INSTALL A CIRCUIT PROTECTION. THE MANUFACTURER HAS NOT YET PROVIDED AN OWNER NOTIFICATION SCHEDULE. OWNERS SHOULD CONTACT JAYCO AT 574-825-5861.

Also, copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

Effective October 21, 2004, Jayco must provide an estimated dealer notification date as well as an owner notification date (month/day/year).
