This letter is to acknowledge your recent defect or noncompliance information report. Please review the following information to ensure that it conforms to your records.

**Potential Number of Units Affected:** 6

**Summary:**  
ON CERTAIN MOTOR HOMES, THE USE OF A 20 AMP CIRCUIT BREAKER IN THE 120V AC PANEL FOR AUDIO/VIDEO EQUIPMENT DOES NOT PROTECT THE CIRCUIT AGAINST COMPONENT FAILURES. THE CIRCUIT IS ONLY RATED FOR A 15 AMP CIRCUIT BREAKER.

**Consequence:**  
THE 20 AMP CIRCUIT BREAKER USED ON THE AUDIO/VIDEO CIRCUIT EXCEEDED LOAD CAPACITY OF THE WIRE. THIS COULD RESULT IN A FIRE.

**Remedy:**

DEALERS WILL REMOVE THE 20 AMP CIRCUIT BREAKER AND INSTALL A 15 AMP CIRCUIT BREAKER. THE RECALL IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN DURING LATE AUGUST OR EARLY SEPTEMBER 2005. OWNERS SHOULD CONTACT COUNTRY COACH AT 800-547-8015.



You are required to submit a draft owner notification letter to this office no less than five days prior to mailing it to the customers. Also, copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin during late August or early September 2005. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due by October 30, 2005.
