**Summary:**

ON CERTAIN TRAILERS EQUIPPED WITH TUTHILL TRAILER SUSPENSIONS, MODELS 20/22 AND RS3162, THE BEAM/AXLE PIVOT CONNECTION JOINT IS MIS-ALIGNED CAUSING EXCESSIVE PLAY WITH THE TRAILER ALLOWING THE TRAILER TO WANDER.

**Consequence:**

A VEHICLE CRASH CAN OCCUR SHOULD THE TRAILER WANDER WITHOUT NOTICE.

**Remedy:**

HYUNDAI TRANSLEAD IS WORKING WITH TUTHILL TO NOTIFY THE OWNERS OF THE AFFECTED VEHICLES AND PROVIDE FREE REMEDY. OWNERS SHOULD CONTACT TUTHILL AT 800-753-0025 OR HYUNDAI AT 1-619-574-1500.

This recall was the subject of an Equipment Query, EQ05-027, conducted by the Office of Defects Investigation.

The information in your defect report appears to satisfy the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6.

Hyundai Translead must notify their customers. Accordingly, you are required to submit a draft owner notification letter to this office no less than five days prior to mailing it to the customers. If you decide to use the sample Tuthill provided, please be aware that a few changes will be needed.

Under "Reason for the Recall," the first sentence needs to begin with "Hyundai Translead, in conjunction with Tuthill Transport Technologies, has decided that a defect ....".

Also at the end of the paragraph, a risk needs to be added.



Additionally, copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

As stated in your report, Tuthill will be conducting the quarterly reporting for this campaign. However, please be advised if Tuthill's campaign is not satisfactorily handled, the agency will require you to renotify owners.
