**Re: Airstream, Inc.
Defect and Non-Compliance Report**

Dear Mr. Person:

Our firm is general counsel for Airstream, Inc. ("Airstream"), P. O. Box 629, 419 W. Pike Street, Jackson Center, Ohio 45334. Airstream recently received notification from Workhorse Custom Chassis ("Workhorse") that the ABS telltale and other warning brake signals on certain chassis supplied to Airstream fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (FMVSS) Nos. 101 and 105. Workhorse has already instituted a safety recall campaign in connection with this matter. The recall number assigned by NHTSA for Workhorse's safety recall campaign is 04V-195.

Pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, we are hereby notifying the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration that certain motorhomes manufactured by Airstream were built on the Workhorse chassis that fail to conform to FMVSS Nos. 101 and 105.

As more specifically set forth below, Workhorse has agreed to conduct the recall campaign involving these non-compliant chassis, including but not limited to providing notification to all of Airstream's potential customers that are subject to the recall campaign, remedying the non-compliance, and filing the quarterly reports in connection with the recall campaign.



- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. The non-compliant chassis supplied by Workhorse have been used on certain 2003 through 2005 model year Land Yacht and Sky Deck gas motorhomes manufactured by Airstream during the period from October 2002 through October 2004. The total number of motorhomes subject to this recall campaign is 213.
- B. Description of Non-Compliance. All of the motorhomes subject to this recall campaign were built on Workhorse chassis that contain an Actia Corporate instrument panel cluster. The non-compliance involves incorrect software programmed into the instrument panel cluster such that certain driver warnings required by FMVSS Nos. 101 and 105 are not displayed. As a result of this incorrect software, the instrument panel cluster may fail to illuminate warning lamps indicating brake system failure codes.
- C. Basis for Determining that a Non-Compliance Exists. Airstream recently received notification from Workhorse that a potential non-compliance exists with respect to the Actia Corporate instrument panel cluster used on certain Workhorse chassis.
- D. Remedying of Non-Compliance. As set forth in the notification issued by Workhorse in connection with recall campaign 04V-195, Workhorse dealers will reprogram the software used in the instrument panel cluster or exchange the instrument panel cluster. The owners of the motorhomes subject to this recall campaign will be advised to contact Workhorse in order to make arrangements to have the remedy completed by Workhorse. Workhorse has agreed to remedy the non-compliance without charge to the owners.
- In order for Workhorse to remedy the defect referred to above, all of the owners of the motorhomes sold by Airstream that are subject to this recall campaign must be notified. Airstream has already completed its obligation to provide Workhorse with the names and addresses of the current owners of such motorhomes. Workhorse will implement the recall campaign in accordance with the procedures specified in recall campaign 04V-195.
- E. Owner Notifications. Workhorse has agreed to provide the notification letters to the owners of the motorhomes that are subject to this recall campaign in accordance with the procedures specified in recall campaign 04V-195.
- F. Quarterly Reporting Requirements. Workhorse will be responsible for filing quarterly reports in connection with recall campaign 04V-195. Because the information included by Workhorse in its quarterly reports will encompass the remedying of the Airstream motorhomes subject to this recall campaign, Airstream will not file quarterly reports to avoid duplication.
- G. Campaign Number. Airstream does not have an internal campaign number for this recall. Airstream will use the recall campaign number assigned by NHTSA.
