5. <u>Description of Noncompliance</u>:

The subject vehicles' tire and loading information label (i.e.; placard) on the driver's side B-pillar incorrectly indicates the spare tire size. This specification does not meet the requirement outlined in S4.3(d) of FMVSS110.

6. Test results and other information

S4.3(b) requires that "Placard. Each vehicle, except for a trailer or incomplete vehicle, shall show the information specified in S4.3 (a) through (g), and may show, at the manufacturer's option, the information specified in S4.3 (h) and (i), on a placard permanently affixed to the driver's side B-pillar. ... (d) Tire size designation, indicated by the headings "size" or "original tire size" or "original size," and "spare tire" or "spare," for the tires installed at the time of the first purchase for purposes other than resale. For full size spare tires, the statement "see above" may, at the manufacturer's option replace the tire size designation. If no spare tire is provided, the word "none" must replace the tire size designation; ..." The placard incorrectly specified a 15 inch spare tire size when it should have specified a 16 inch spare tire size.

7. <u>Description of Corrective Repair Action:</u>

All known owners of the affected vehicles will be notified by first class mail with the correct tire and loading information label that they are to affix over the incorrect label.

Reimbursement Plan for pre-notification remedies:

Per 49 CFR 573.13(m), reimbursement does not apply.

8. <u>Recall Schedule:</u>

Mailing of the owner notifications will commence in early December, 2005 and be completed by the end of December, 2005.

Copies of the owner notification and dealer instructions will be submitted as soon as they are available.

9. <u>Distributor/Dealer Notification Schedule:</u>

Notifications to distributors/dealers will be sent at the end of November.
