Dear Skyline Recreational Vehicle Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

#### REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Skyline Corporation has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in its 2005 and 2006 "Nomad Limited" and "Layton Limited" travel trailers. The data plate and certification label list Goodyear tires, tire size and indicate that they are radial tires. The cold inflation pressure is listed as 35. The tires are Duro bias tires, 205/75 with a cold inflation pressure of 50. Underinflation of the tires could result in rapid tire wear and premature failure that could result in a loss of control of the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash.

#### WHAT WE WILL DO

Enclosed are a replacement data plate and certification label.

#### WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Affix the replacement data plate over the data plate located in an overhead kitchen cupboard. Affix the replacement certification label over the certification label located on the road side front bottom corner of the outside of the trailer. The fix should take less than five minutes. If you have trouble locating the data plate or certification label, call the service manager at the Skyline factory at 1-800-736-2573 between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. EST Monday-Friday. He can assist you in locating the data plate and/or certification label.
