Dear Skyline Dealer:

On May 19, 2005, Skyline contacted the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to report a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety in its 2005 and 2006 "Nomad Limited" and "Layton Limited" travel trailers manufactured between February 21, 2005 and May 10, 2005 at the Skyline manufacturing facility in Elkhart, Indiana.

The data plate and certification label list Goodyear tires, tire size and indicate that they are radial tires. The cold inflation pressure is listed as 35. The tires are Duro bias tires, 205/75 with a cold inflation pressure of 50. Underinflation of the tires could result in rapid tire wear and premature failure that could result in a loss of control of the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash.

Skyline will contact all customers who purchased one of these recreational vehicles. Our records show that you received the following units. The following units remain in your stock. Please replace the data plate (located inside an overhead cabinet) and the certification label (affixed to the road side front bottom corner) with the replacement labels enclosed.
