

Dear Skyline Dealer:

On June 8, 2005, Skyline contacted the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration to report a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety in its 2006 "Nomad Limited", "Layton Limited" and "Aljo "Limited" travel trailers manufactured between April 29, 2005 and May 13, 2005 at the Skyline manufacturing facility in Elkhart, Indiana.

The defect is the result of incorrect certification labels showing the tire inflation pressure as 35 rather than 50 psi. Underinflation of the tires can lead to rapid tire wear and premature failure that could result in a loss of control of the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash without prior warning.

Skyline will contact all customers who purchased one of these recreational vehicles. Our records show that you received the following units. The following units remain in your stock. Please replace the certification label (affixed to the road side front bottom corner) with the replacement labels enclosed.

Dear Skyline Recreational Vehicle Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Skyline Corporation has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in its 2006 "Nomad Limited", "Layton Limited" and "Aljo Limited" travel trailers. The certification label lists the cold inflation pressure as 35. The cold inflation pressure is 50. Underinflation of the tires could result in rapid tire wear and premature failure that could result in a loss of control of the vehicle, increasing the risk of a crash. This could occur without prior warning.

WHAT WE WILL DO

Enclosed is a replacement certification label.

WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

Affix the replacement certification label over the certification label located on the road side front bottom corner of the outside of the trailer. The fix should take less than five minutes. If you have trouble locating the data plate or certification label, call the service manager at the Skyline factory at 1-800-929-1080 between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. PDST Monday-Friday. He can assist you in locating the certification label.

If you are not able to have the safety defect remedied without charge and within a reasonable time, you may wish to write the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 400 Seventh Street, S.W., Washington, DC 20590 or call 1-888-327-4236.
