**RE:** 2006 Accord Campaign Announcement and Stop Sale Order

Today, Honda Motor Co., Ltd., announced to NHTSA (National Highway Traffic Safety Administration) its intention to recall selected 2006 Accord L-4 model vehicles in order to inspect their tires for damage.

**Basic Problem:** The problem involves loss of air to the tires as the result of cuts to the tire inner liner, at the bead area during the tire mounting process.

**Stop-Sale Order:** Applies to 293 selected HAM-built 2006 Accord L-4 models between VIN 1HGCM5\*\*\*\*A003079 and VIN 1HGCM5\*\*\*\*A027547 in your vehicle inventory.

**NOTE 1:** The range is very wide and the actual number of vehicles is small, so it is imperative that you use the attached link below (*see Link To Affected VINs*) to see if you have a vehicle affected by this Stop Sale Order. Affected vehicles are scattered throughout the United States and Puerto Rico. Vehicles listed in the link **CANNOT** be sold or leased with a known defect.

**NOTE 2:** It is illegal to sell or lease a vehicle with a known defect. If any affected vehicle is sold/leased to a retail customer with a known defect, the dealership will be entirely responsible for all legal consequences, should an injury occur as a result of a failure of the defective part.

**Support Materials:** American Honda will post its recall repair service bulletin on ISIS tonight (11/11/05) and will be printable on the 12<sup>th</sup>. A Campaign Responsibility Report of all your affected vehicles will be mailed next week.

**Campaign Parts:** If a tire(s) is damaged, please contact the Tire Rack for a replacement.

**Repair Strategy:** Inspect all four tires for damage and replace any that are damaged. Refer to service bulletin for specific inspection/repair instructions.

**Customer Notification:** This Recall Campaign affects Approximately 1,606 vehicles. Notifications will be mailed to all known owners the week of November 14, 2005.
