REF: NHTSA Recall Follow-up Notification (# 05V-244)

A total of 248 units were involved in the recall renotification campaign. During the search of VIN numbers for the corresponding Hackney serial numbers a total of 6 units were found to be repair units and should not have been in the original recall list in the first place.

With the help of R.L. Polk & Co., A "VIN# to address" match was carried out for the remaining 242 units. Hackney received an updated owner list based on the current state motor vehicle registration records. According to the records furnished by R.L. Polk & Co., only 131 units are currently registered with a state. Therefore, 131 notifications were sent out to the customers before March 30, 2007.

The remaining 111 units are untrackable due to, but not limited to the following reasons: the unit was sold to federal government or exported.
