
Dear Mr. Warmoth:

We have reviewed Weekend Warrior's proposed owner letter and it does not meet the requirements for such letters under Federal law. See 49 CFR Part 577.5. We have enclosed a rewritten owner letter for you to consider in notifying your owners of this recall. Please submit a revised draft that complies with Federal law as soon as possible.

Also, in accordance with NHTSA's letter to Weekend Warrior of January 17, 2007, you were to provide this agency with the estimated date(s) on which Weekend Warrior will begin sending notifications to owners, and to dealers and distributors, and the estimated date(s) on which it will complete these notifications. This information was to be provided to the agency no later than **10 business days from January 17, 2007.** Weekend Warrior has not yet provided this information and it must be provided immediately.

Please also be reminded that copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent.

Dear Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

**REASON FOR THIS RECALL**

Weekend Warrior Trailers, Incorporated has decided that certain MY 2001-2005 CL, FB, FK, FS, FT, LE, SL, SLC, MY 2001-2004 FBD, MY 2001-2003 SE, SP, and MY 2004-2005 FSC AND SX recreational trailers fail to conform to the lighting requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108, "Lamps, Reflective Devices, and Associated Equipment." Specifically, certain trailers were manufactured without all required lighting equipment. Without this lighting, and particularly, during night driving conditions or while the trailer is parked, other vehicles may not see a trailer, thereby, increasing the risk of a crash.

Weekend Warrior Trailers, Incorporated or an authorized dealer will add the missing equipment to enhance visibility. This service will be performed for you at no charge.

**WHAT YOU SHOULD DO**

Please contact Weekend Warrior Trailers, Incorporated at (800) 500-9914 (option #3 for service) or your nearest dealer as soon as possible to arrange a service date. We estimate this service can be completed within 1-5 days of the receipt of your trailer. If you take your vehicle to an authorized dealer on the agreed service date, and they do not remedy this condition within 5 days, we recommend you contact us to monitor your service.

**Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.**

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact .....

We regret any inconvenience that this action may cause you. However, we are concerned about your safety.
