This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Home & Park Motorhomes has determined that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the **BBQ line** installed on Roadtrek class 'B' motorhomes manufactured between March – October on 2005 - 2006 Chevrolet 2500 regular van and the 3500 extended van.

The defect relates to a missing support clamp attached to the BBQ line. Under certain conditions, the BBQ line could fall and drag on the ground wearing a hole through the line. If the line wears through a propane gas leak will occur, creating the potential for a fire without warning.

Corrective action requires installation of the support clamp, preventing the line from making contact with the ground when hanging freely. Please contact your Roadtrek Dealer to have the repairs completed. The repairs will take less than one half hour and will be completed at no charge to you.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
