Dear Pat,

Enclosed please find my first official recall update. I sent in the preliminary one a few weeks back, but this one includes everything I have in my file also. All correspondence, e-mails, tracking, credits for repairs etc. So you have everything I have.

The **colored** spreadsheet ledger is the main document I use and keep updated daily as to the progress of the trailers. To date, of the 208 trailers affected by the recall, I have:

150 repaired

31 that have kits sent and many of them by now are repaired, I just don't have the documentation back yet.

1 is in Dillingham Alaska, and the owner is too far away to get it, when he pulls it out next spring he will contact us and we will arrange for repair.

14 are still being pursued by the dealers to find out where they went.

8 are in Greece and we are having difficulty in getting them to respond

1 is in Hawaii, the owner has moved with no forwarding address, we're still working on this one.


1 trailer listed on the sheet is a duplicate VIN number, in other words there are really 207 trailers affected, not 208

1 is in Washington State but the dealer has not found the paperwork yet to tell us the retail persons name.

To boil that down, as soon as get documentation back on the trailers that have had kits sent for repair, we'll have 181 repaired and only 26 left yet to repair.
