RE: SR-05-005 - 2005 Endeavor and Galant Brake Master Cylinder Recall

We regret to inform you of a safety recall campaign on certain 2005 Galant and Endeavor vehicles equipped with ABS. Do not deliver, sell, lease, wholesale trade, or operate on public or private roadway, any 2005 ABS-equipped Galant or Endeavor vehicle unless repairs are performed as described in SR-05-005, or it is verified that the vehicle is not affected by this recall. This notice is in accordance with Title 49, CFR 573; of the NHTSA regulation, prohibiting the sale or lease of defective vehicles prior to correction of a defect. Safety Recall Bulletin SR-05-005 is now available on the Mitsubishi Dealer Link and MEDIC. Paper copies of the bulletin are being sent to dealers via overnight mail today, including a list of affected VINs in your inventory as of September 21, 2005, and a list of retailed affected VINs.

<u>Affected Vehicles</u>

ABS-equipped 2005 Mitsubishi Galant and Endeavor models produced on or between the following dates:

2005 Galant May 25, 2005 through July 13, 2005 2005 Endeavor May 25, 2005 through August 10, 2005

Check the SuperScreen to verify affected units. Vehicles without ABS and vehicles produced before/after the above dates are not involved in this recall campaign. Affected vehicles involved will show <u>C0506MXX</u> as an open campaign.

Purpose

Some affected vehicles may have a brake master cylinder with an improperly assembled master cylinder. The improperly assembled master cylinder could allow fluid to bypass internally, increasing brake pedal stroke ("travel"). This recall is for a different condition than SR-05-003 for 2006 Eclipse models.

Do Not Sell Unless Repairs Are Performed

Effective immediately, do not demo, trade or retail any 2005 Galant or Endeavor vehicles until repairs are performed or it is confirmed that the vehicle is **not** included in this recall campaign. After repairs are performed, you may sell corrected units.

Customers' Vehicles

Customers will receive notice of this recall by first class mail on or about October 3, 2005. A sample copy of the notice is contained in the recall bulletin. A list of the affected vehicles that were retailed by your dealership is included with the paper copy of SR-05-005.

Repairs and Parts


Replace the brake master cylinder as described in SR-05-005. Please follow the campaign claim instructions in SR-05-005 and submit claims promptly. A supply of new brake master cylinders will be automatically shipped to your dealership, based on your affected vehicle inventory as of September 21, 2005. Order additional parts for customer vehicles based on the retailed VIN list included with the paper copy of SR-05-005.

PURPOSE

Some affected vehicles may have a defective brake master cylinder. An internal seal may have been installed incorrectly, allowing brake fluid to bypass during braking, resulting in partial reduction in braking function, which could lead to a crash.

Dealers are instructed to <u>replace the master cylinder on all affected vehicles</u>, using the appropriate replacement master cylinder listed in the PARTS INFORMATION section of this bulletin.

AFFECTED VEHICLES

For U.S.:

2005 Galant equipped with anti-lock brakes (ABS) produced between 5/25/05 and 7/13/05 2005 Endeavor equipped with anti-lock brakes (ABS) produced between 5/25/05 and 8/10/05

For Canada:

2005 Galant equipped with anti-lock brakes (ABS) produced on 5/26/05 2005 Endeavor equipped with anti-lock brakes (ABS) produced between 5/25/05 and 7/19/05

IMPORTANT

Affected new or used inventory vehicles must be repaired before the vehicle is sold. Dealers must check their inventory vehicles' VINs on the Warranty Super Screen to verify whether the vehicle is involved in this recall campaign.

CUSTOMER NOTIFICATION

A letter will be sent to all owners of affected vehicles, asking them to bring their vehicle to their selling Mitsubishi Motors dealer to have the brake master cylinder replaced. A copy of the customer notification letter appears later in this bulletin. Dealers are also asked to contact their customers (by phone, e-mail, or fax), asking them to bring their vehicle to the dealership for this repair.

REQUIRED OPERATIONS

Before starting this campaign procedure, **CHECK ON THE WARRANTY SUPERSCREEN** to verify that the vehicle is an affected VIN for this recall campaign and that this recall campaign procedure has not already been completed.

- 1. Record the customer's audio system settings, so you can re-set them after the battery is reconnected.
- 2. Remove the strut tower bar (if equipped).
- Remove the battery.




- 4. Remove the intake air hose, air cleaner, and top half of the air cleaner housing.
- 5. Release vacuum from the brake booster.
- 6. Disconnect the brake fluid level indicator switch connector.

⚠ CAUTION

Be careful during this procedure to prevent spilling any brake fluid on painted surfaces.


- 7. Drain the brake fluid from the master cylinder and dispose of properly.
- 8. Disconnect the brake lines from the master cylinder.
- 9. Remove the brake master cylinder from the brake booster. keeping the brake fluid reservoir and hoses attached to the master cylinder.
 - a. Remove and save the attachment nuts for re-use.






- 10. Install the brake fluid reservoir and hoses onto the new master cylinder. Refer to the PARTS INFORMATION section of this bulletin.
- 11. Install the new brake master cylinder onto the brake booster. Tighten the attachment nuts to: Endeavor -25 ± 2 Nm (18 ± 2 ft/lb)

 Galant -13 ± 2 Nm (10 ± 1 ft/lbs)
- 12. Connect the brake fluid level indicator switch connector.
- 13. Fill the master cylinder reservoir with brake fluid. Use Mitsubishi Brake Fluid p/n MZ311987. Note: On Endeavor models, lightly tap the brake fluid reservoir and hoses to remove air bubbles.
- 14. Thoroughly bleed the master cylinder and brake lines as follows:



- a. Press and hold the brake pedal.
- b. Have another person cover the master cylinder outlets with their fingers.
- c. Release the brake pedal.
- d. Repeat steps a. through c. at least three times, holding the pedal to the floor the third time. Ensure that all air is removed.
- 15. Install the brake lines to the new brake master cylinder. Tighten the brake line attachment nuts to 15 ± 2 Nm (12 ± 1 ft/lb).
- 16. Use brake cleaner to remove any brake fluid on the battery tray.
- 17. Reinstall the battery.
- 18. Reinstall the air intake hose, air cleaner housing, and air cleaner.
- 19. Reinstall the strut tower bar (if equipped).



20. Start the engine and bleed the air in the brake lines at each caliper, in the sequence shown.

- 21. Reset the customer's audio system settings.
- 22. CANADA VEHICLES ONLY: The outside temperature display defaults to Fahrenheit degrees when power is interrupted, such as battery disconnection. To change the display to Celsius degrees, push in the "H" and "M" buttons at the same time, and hold for 10 seconds.

23. THROTTLE BODY INITIALIZATION PROCEDURE

Initialize the throttle body as follows: Turn the ignition switch to ON, then to OFF. Wait for at least 10 seconds before turning the key back to ON.

PARTS INFORMATION

A supply of master cylinders for both models will be automatically shipped to each dealer, based on in-stock inventory as of 9/21/05. Additional parts can be ordered through the normal parts system.

Due to the limited number of affected Galants for this campaign, dealers should not order additional master cylinders for Galants unless they have actual customer requests.

If the part is requested during those 5 days, you must return the part to the location indicated on the parts return request letter.


If you not receive a request after 5 days from the claim payment date, you may scrap the replaced brake master cylinder.



Specific 2005 Galants and Endeavors with ABS Brakes Brake Master Cylinder Replacement



RE: IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTIFICATION: SR-05-005

Dear Mitsubishi Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Reason For Notice:

Mitsubishi Motors North America, Inc. has decided that a defect that relates to vehicle safety exists in certain 2005 Galant and Endeavor vehicles equipped with anti-lock brakes. The brake master cylinder, which controls the fluid pressure to your vehicle's brakes, may allow brake fluid to bypass internally during stopping. This may result in partial loss of braking, increased stopping distances and could lead to a vehicle crash.

What you should do:

Please contact your Authorized Mitsubishi Dealer to schedule a repair date. Parts for your vehicle have already been allocated to the selling dealership. If you must go to a dealer other than your selling dealer, please contact Mitsubishi Customer Relations at 1-888-648-7820 to arrange for special parts handling. When you bring your vehicle in, show this letter. (If you misplace this letter, they will still make the repair, free of charge.)

What your dealer will do:

The dealership will replace the brake master cylinder.

How long will it take?

The time needed for the actual repair is approximately 2 hours. The dealer may need your vehicle for a longer period of time due to service scheduling issues, but every effort will be made to minimize your inconvenience.

Notice to Lessors: If you are a lessor of five or more leased vehicles as of the date of this letter, you have an obligation under federal law, (49 CFR Part 577), to provide the lessee of the above referenced vehicle with a copy of this letter by first class mail within ten days of receipt. Further, you must maintain a record, which identifies the lessee to whom you sent a copy of this letter, the date you sent it, and the vehicle identification number (VIN) of the subject vehicle.
