FOLLOW UP NOTIFICATION

Dear Infiniti Owner:

This second notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Nissan Motor Company, Ltd. has decided that certain 2005 model year Infiniti FX35/45 vehicles do not meet one of the requirements specified in Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 225, "Child Restraint Anchorage Systems."

Reason for Recall

FMVSS No. 225 specifies certain requirements for child seat anchorage systems in vehicles. The lower anchorage brackets in the rear seats of some FX35/45 vehicles do not meet the anchorage location requirement. This may cause difficulty in attaching some child seats to these brackets. If a child seat is not secured, there is an increased risk of injury in a crash. All other requirements under FMVSS No. 225 and other standards are met.

What Infiniti Will Do

Your Infiniti dealer will replace the lower anchorage brackets with modified ones to ensure that the standard is met all at no cost to you.

What You Should Do

If you have not done so already, we urge you to please contact your Infiniti dealer at your earliest convenience in order to arrange an appointment to have your vehicle repaired. Please bring this notice with you when you go to your service appointment. Instructions to repair your vehicle have been sent to your Infiniti dealer.
