RE: **Notice of Recall, 2004-01 (Chevrolet - Continental Spare Tire Carrier)
(NHTSA 04V-466)**

This is a follow up to a notice that was sent to you in October 2004. Our records indicate that you have not yet had the repair work done on your vehicle.

Roadtrek Motorhomes Inc. (formerly Home & Park Motorhomes) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the **optional Continental Spare Tire Kit** installed on Roadtrek class 'B' motorhomes manufactured on 2001 - 2004 Chevrolet 2500 regular van and the 3500 extended van.

The defect relates to the metal fatigue a component of the Continental Spare Tire carrier. Under certain conditions, the tire carrier locator receiver bracket may break loose of the trailer hitch, separating from the vehicle. If the tire carrier breaks loose from the trailer hitch, the carrier may strike vehicles following behind you, causing a crash without warning.

Corrective action requires the receiver bracket to be welded to the trailer hitch. Please contact your Roadtrek dealer or a local welding facility to have the repairs completed. The repairs will take less than one half hour and will be completed at no charge to you.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. Please ensure that you provide the repair facility with the enclosed instructions. The recall form must be completed and returned to Roadtrek Motorhomes in the self addressed stamped envelope.

We regret any inconvenience these actions may cause. It is imperative to have the above corrective action completed for your safety and satisfaction with your Roadtrek.
