**Summary:**

CERTAIN AFTERMARKET TALL WINDSCREENS, P/N 58214-06YA, SOLD EXCLUSIVELY FOR USE ON 2006 MY BUELL ULYSSES MOTORCYCLES. THE RETENTION FASTENERS FOR THE SUBJECT WINDSCREENS CAN FAIL ALLOWING THE WINDSCREEN TO BECOME DISLODGED WHILE THE VEHICLE IS BEING DRIVEN AT HIGHWAY SPEEDS.

**Consequence:**

THE WINDSCREEN MAY EITHER STRIKE OR DISTRACT THE RIDER, POSSIBLY CAUSING DEATH OR INJURY.

**Remedy:**

BUELL WILL NOTIFY OWNERS AND REPLACE THE WINDSCREEN FREE OF CHARGE. THE RECALL IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN DURING JULY 2006. OWNERS MAY CONTACT BUELL DISTRIBUTION COMPANY, LLC AT 1-414-343-8400.


The information in your defect report appears to satisfy the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6.

We have received Buell's proposed owner notification letter and it is currently under review. You will be notified of any changes or concerns once our review is complete. Copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, the recall is expected to begin during July 2006. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due in this office on or before 30 days after the close of the calendar quarter.
