ON CERTAIN VEHICLES, THE INSTRUMENT CLUSTER BACKLIGHTING CAN EXPERIENCE ELECTRICAL MALFUNCTIONS RESULTING IN THE FAILURE TO ILLUMINATE THE GAUGES.

Consequence:

THE DRIVER COULD BE UNABLE TO READ THE GAUGES AND INDICATORS, SUCH AS THE SPEEDOMETER, WHICH COULD INCREASE THE RISK OF A CRASH.

Remedy:

DEALERS WILL REPLACE THE INSTRUMENT CLUSTER MODULES FREE OF CHARGE. THE MANUFACTURER HAS NOT YET PROVIDED AN OWNER NOTIFICATION SCHEDULE. OWNERS MAY CONTACT MERCEDES-BENZ AT 1-800-367-6372.
