ON CERTAIN SPORTS/CAMPER TRAILERS EQUIPPED WITH FURNACES, THE FURNACE WAS IMPROPERLY INSTALLED SO THAT THE EXHAUST VENT DISCHARGED INTO THE OCCUPIED SPACE OF THE TRAILER AND THE HEATED AIR DISCHARGED OUTSIDE OF THE TRAILER.

Consequence:
CARBON MONOXIDE IN THE LIVING QUARTERS COULD CAUSE INJURY OR DEATH.

Remedy:

DEALERS WILL CORRECTLY POSITION THE EXHAUST VENT. THE RECALL BEGAN ON JANUARY 23, 2006. OWNERS MAY CONTACT PACE AMERICAN AT 800-247-5767.



Please provide the following additional information and be reminded of the following requirements:

You are required to submit a draft owner notification letter to this office no less than five days prior to mailing it to the customers. Also, copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification began on January 23, 2006. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on or before April 30, 2006.
