### **Summary:**

ON CERTAIN PICKUP TRUCKS AND SPORT UTILITY VEHICLES, AN ELECTROSTATIC DISCHARGE EVENT BETWEEN THE OPERATOR AND THE VEHICLE CAN RESULT IN A LOSS OF TURN SIGNAL FUNCTIONALITY AND HEADLAMP OR WINDSHIELD WIPER ACTIVATION OR DEACTIVATION.

# Consequence:

THIS CAN IMPAIR THE DRIVER'S VISION AND CAUSE A CRASH WITHOUT WARNING.

# Remedy:

DEALERS WILL RE-FLASH THE INSTRUMENT CLUSTER. THE RECALL IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN DURING FEBRUARY 2006. OWNERS MAY CONTACT DAIMLERCHRYSLER AT 1-800-853-1403.

You are required to submit a draft owner notification letter to this office no less than five days prior to mailing it to the customers. Also, copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin during February 2006. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on or before April 30, 2006.
