Summary:

ON CERTAIN VANS EQUIPPED WITH THE POWER LIFTGATE OPTION THE POWER LIFTGATE MOTOR AUTOMATICALLY DISENGAGES AFTER THE LIFTGATE IS POWERED OPEN.

Consequence:

IN THE EVENT OF A LIFTGATE STRUT MALFUNCTION, THE LIFTGATE CAN FALL FREELY WITH NO PRIOR WARNING. ANYONE STANDING BENEATH THE LIFTGATE MAY BE INJURED IF THE LIFTGATE FALLS.

Remedy:

DEALERS WILL REPROGRAM THE POWER LIFTGATE MODULE TO ELIMINATE THE POTENTIAL FOR THE LIFTGATE TO FALL FREE OF CHARGE. THE RECALL BEGAN ON MARCH 13, 2006. OWNERS MAY CONTACT FORD AT 1-800-392-3673.

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification began on March 13, 2006. Therefore, the first quarterly report will be due on or before April 30, 2006.
