CERTAIN TOWABLE TRAVEL TRAILERS FAIL TO CONFORM TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF FEDERAL MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY STANDARD NO. 100, 'TIRE SELECTION AND RIMS.' THESE TRAILERS ARE MISSING THE TIRE INFORMATION PLACARD.

Consequence:

THIS DOES NOT MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STANDARD.

Remedy:

This recall was the subject of an investigation, PE-110-060306, conducted by the Office of Vehicle Safety Compliance.

We have reviewed your proposed owner letter and it does not meet the requirements of Part 577.

Please change the first sentence to read: "This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act."

Please change the first sentence of the second paragraph to read: "KZRV, L.P., has decided that certain 2006 model year Durango, Sportster, Frontier, Coyote, Jag, Spree, and Sportsmen travel trailers manufactured between September 1, 2005 and March 9, 2006, fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 110, "Tire Selection and Rims."

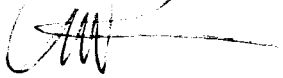
Also, please add the following sentence to the dealer and owner letter: "Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days."

Copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within one month after the close of the calendar quarter in which notification to purchasers occurs. As stated in your report, owner notification is expected to begin on or before March 24, 2006. Since this is so close to the end of the quarter, the first quarterly report will be due on or before July 30, 2006.
