ON CERTAIN CLASS A MOTOR HOMES, THE WINDSHIELD WIPER MOTORS ARE UNDER-FUSED AND THE FUSE MAY FAIL.

**Consequence:**

IF THE FUSE FAILS, THE WINDSHIELD WIPERS WILL STOP FUNCTIONING WHICH WOULD RESULT IN A DECREASE OF THE VISIBILITY OF THE OPERATOR AND COULD RESULT IN A CRASH.

**Remedy:**

DEALERS WILL INSTALL A NEW 15 AMP AUTO RESETTING CIRCUIT BREAKER FUSE ON THE VEHICLE. THE RECALL IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN DURING LATE NOVEMBER OR EARLY DECEMBER 2006. OWNERS MAY CONTACT MONACO AT 1-800-685-6545.


Please provide the following additional information and be reminded of the following requirements:
