Affected vehicles are Model Year 2006 Travel Star and Antigua travel trailers (models 27TB and 25TB) manufactured with the optional fuel station between August 1, 2005 and February 7, 2006.

The recall population was determined from the manufacturing records for Starcraft's manufacturing plant in Topeka, Indiana, which produced the affected travel trailers.

A total of seventy-nine (79) travel trailers are subject to this recall. Specific Vehicle Identification Numbers (VIN) are as follows: 1SATS02L662EJ2206 - 1SATS02L362EJ2261; 1SATS02N862ET2006 - 1SATS02N562ET2027; Antigua 27TBs 1SATS02N062CT1006 - 1SATS02N262CT1007 and an Antigua 25TB 1SATS02LX62CC1206.

Starcraft is estimating the number of trailers affected by this condition to be seventy-nine (79) units. It is, however, recalling 100 percent of the travel trailers equipped with the vendor supplied fuel pump.

Starcraft was notified by Great Plains Industries, Inc. that certain 2006 Travel Star and Antigua travel trailers, with the optional fuel station having the vendor supplied fuel pump, can leak fuel, which may result in fire, injury or death.


The remedy for affected travel trailers will involve replacement of any defective pumps.

Copies of the repair instructions, dealer notification letters and owner letters will be provided to the agency within ten (10) business days. Starcraft is prepared to begin dealer notification with five (5) business days thereafter, and owner notification within ten (10) business days subsequent to dealer notification.
