

573.6 (c) (3) Number of Vehicles Potentially Containing the Defect

Approximately 362,000 vehicles are affected by this recall in the United States.

573.6 (c) (4) Percentage of Vehicles Actually Containing Defect

VWoA is unable to estimate the percentage of vehicles in the United States that are subject to this defect.

573.6 (c) (5) Description of Defect

The affected vehicles may have a brake light switch that may malfunction if it was installed incorrectly in recalls NHTSA # 03V-265 or 04V-096. If this happens, the brake lights could become inoperative or remain on. Failure to provide the proper signal when braking could lead to a crash without warning.

573.6 (c) (6) Basis for Determination

Response to NHTSA RQ 06-004, customer complaints and internal investigation.

Date of determination: May 19, 2006.

573.6 (c) (7) Noncompliance Test Result

Not applicable

573.6 (c) (8) Proposed Remedial Program

When sufficient quantities of the newly designed switch are available, VWoA plans to notify all owners of affected vehicles and will instruct them to arrange for an appointment with an authorized dealer. The dealers will install the newly designed brake light switch at no cost to customers, regardless of if/when any previous level switch was installed in, or subsequent to, the recall.

Pending parts availability, mailing dates are anticipated as follows:

Dealers: on or before December 5, 2006 Owners: on or before December 8, 2006

Until the new switch is available, VWoA will repair any subject vehicles that are presented for repair to authorized VW dealers with malfunctioning brake light switches using the current level design free of charge.

573.6 (c) (9) Submission of Communications

A representative copy of all bulletins and other communications sent to dealers and owners will be submitted within five (5) days of dealer/owner notification.

573.6 (c) (10) Proposed Owner Letter

Draft owner's letter will be submitted within five (5) days of owner notification.

573.6 (c) (11) Manufacturer's Recall Code

VWoA has assigned the code "N4" for this recall.
