
This document updates the DaimlerChrysler Corporation (DCC) Defect Information Report for DCC recall F25 submitted to you on June 6, 2006.

The inclusive date of manufacture for the 2000 MY Jeep Grand Cherokee vehicles has been extended to 6/12/00. Accordingly, the estimated volume for the 2000 MY vehicles has increased to 79,658.

The number of customer complaints that appeared potentially related to this condition in the chronology increased by 72, not 12 as reported. In addition, the search of input data for other products and model years for which the subject fan was utilized found 28 customer complaints for the 2000 MY Jeep Grand Cherokee 4.0L vehicle, not 34 as reported.

Finally, DCC expects to begin national notification to both dealers and to owners in August of 2006.
