Dear Mr. Person:

National RV, Inc. has decided that certain motor homes it manufactured have a safety defect because they were not equipped with a fuel fill ground cable. National RV is hereby providing notification to your office in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573.

4. 573.5 (c)(4) Approximate percentage of equipment estimated to actually contain the noncompliance:

100% of the motor homes identified in item 3, above.

5. 573.5 (c)(5) Description of the noncompliance:

The motor homes identified above were not equipped with fuel fill ground cables.

6. 573.6(c)(7) – Basis

This issue was first identified as a potential safety defect in August 2006 and promptly submitted to National RV's Product Safety Committee and its Legal Department. After an investigative period, National RV decided that the motorhomes required installation of the fuel fill ground cable. This conclusion was reached on August 24, 2006.

7. 573.5 (c)(8) Description of proposed remedy:

National RV will install the fuel fill ground cable on affected units.

8. Program for Remedy Campaign:

National RV will notify all owners of the involved motor homes and will remedy the motor homes free of charge to the owners. Notices will be mailed to the owners via Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, and First Class Mail. National RV will also notify its dealers and authorized service providers via broadcast fax and First Class Mail.


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9. **573.6(c)(9) – Press statement and Dealer/Owner Letters**
