This letter is written to notify the NHTSA that Universal Specialty Vehicles, Inc. is aware of the voluntary initiation of a recall notification campaign affecting produced recreational vehicles as listed below:

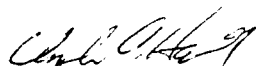

This voluntary recall campaign involves approximately 16 Universal Specialty Vehicles, Inc. class A motor homes manufactured with Workhorse chassis.

The reason for the recall is the possible installation of an improperly heat treated fuel rail damper retainer clip. An improperly heat treated clip may break resulting in a gasoline fuel leak at the fuel rail damper. A vehicle fire can result if the leaking fuel is ignited by a spark, or flame.

Universal Specialty Vehicles, Inc. has no reason to disagree with this action or the recall remedy. Universal Specialty Vehicles, Inc. is relying on Workhorse Custom Chassis and the NHTSA to monitor campaign performance.
