Re: Safety Defect Report - REVISED

Dear Mr. Weinstein:

On October 17, 2006, Fleetwood Enterprises Inc., decided that a non-compliance to the requirements of Part 567 "Certification" exists in motor homes as listed below and is furnishing this notification in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Non-compliance reports.

The following is the information required by 49 CFR Part 573:

- This report was prepared on December 7, 2006.
 - Fleetwood has assigned 61020 as an identification code to this recall.
- (1) The affected motor homes were manufactured by the following wholly owned subsidiaries of Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc.

- (2) The vehicles involved in this recall are 2007 model year Tioga and Jamboree Class C motor homes manufactured from March 6, 2006 through October 5, 2006. The October 5, 2006 date coincides with correct rear tire pressure rating Federal Certification tags being applied to the motor homes during production. These motor homes were built with a Fleetwood identification number range of 741D74794140 through 878D74793661.

- (3) Fleetwood reports 192 as an approximate number of Tioga and Jamboree Class C motor homes containing the non-compliance.
- (4) Fleetwood estimates that 100% of the above Tioga and Jamboree Class C motor homes contain the non-compliance.
- (5) On Tioga and Jamboree Class C motor homes affected by this recall, the Manufacturer Federal Certification tag figures related to the rear tire pressure rating of 60 psi are incorrect. The correct rear tire pressure rating is 80 psi. Please note that all other values are correct.
- (6) Not applicable.
- (7) Fleetwood began an investigation in October 2006 when the non-compliance was discovered at our manufacturing plant.

Fleetwood is not aware of any accidents or injuries that have resulted from this non-compliance.

- (8) Fleetwood will mail corrected Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification tags to dealers and owner's of record and will ask that they deface the original Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification Tag and replace it with the new serial number specific Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification Tag. Dealers and owners of record will be asked to check and if necessary adjust tire pressure to 80 psi. Owners who are not comfortable installing this label or checking tire pressures will be asked to contact their selling dealer to have this service performed at no charge.
- (9) Fleetwood intends to conduct a dealer notification mailing on January 16, 2007.
Fleetwood intends to conduct a customer notification mailing on January 23, 2007.

Fleetwood does not foresee any problems with implementing this voluntary recall campaign.

- (10) Copies of subsequent correspondence will be submitted to the NHTSA within five (5) working days of distribution. This correspondence will include:
 - I) Letter of dealer notification
 - II) Letter of customer notification
 - III) Service Bulletin

IMPORTANT RECALL INFORMATION #61020

Dear Valued Fleetwood Motor Home Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., on behalf of its subsidiary manufacturing centers located in Riverside, California and Paxinos, Pennsylvania has decided that certain 2007 model year Tioga and Jamboree Class C motor homes fail to comply with the requirements of Part 567, "Certification".

WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

Fleetwood Enterprises, Inc., has become aware of a rear tire psi rating input error. The Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification Tag was printed with an incorrect rear tire value of 60 pounds per square inch air pressure (psi). The correct rear tire pressure value is 80 psi. Please note that all other values are correct.

A misprinted label could lead to improper vehicle loading or tire inflation which could result in tire failure, increasing the risk of a crash.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

Deface the original Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification Tag and replace it with the new serial number specific Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification Tag that is enclosed with this letter. You can locate the tag on the sidewall near the driver's seat of the motor home. **Note: Please peel the backing before applying over the defaced original Federal Certification Tag.** Check and if necessary, inflate the rear tires to the correct 80 psi.

After you have completed this procedure, please return the enclosed serialized pre-addressed ***Vehicle Information Update Card*** to Fleetwood.

If you do not feel comfortable installing this tag or checking rear tire pressures, you may take your motor home to any Fleetwood dealer and they will perform this service at no charge to you.

When you deliver your motor home for repairs, your dealer will complete a ***Fleetwood Repair Order***. Upon completion of the repair, please sign the ***Fleetwood Repair Order*** and fill out the enclosed, self-addressed ***Vehicle Information Update Card***, and return it to Fleetwood.

If you have changed your address or sold the motor home, please take a moment to provide the name and address of the person or dealership you sold it to on the enclosed ***Vehicle Information Update Card***, and return it to Fleetwood. This will enable us to update our records, and if necessary, notify the new owner using the information you provide.

If you have had this concern corrected previously, you may be eligible for reimbursement of your cost for that repair. For more information regarding this recall #61020, contact Fleetwood Owner Relations at 800-505-3418.

For leased vehicles: Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

Tioga and Jamboree Class C Federal Certification Tag**

Fleetwood Enterprises Inc., on behalf of its subsidiary manufacturing centers located in Riverside, California and Paxinos, Pennsylvania is requesting your assistance in conducting a voluntary recall notification campaign in accordance with the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Fleetwood Enterprises Inc., has decided that certain 2007 model year Tioga and Jamboree Class C motor homes built at our Riverside, California and Paxinos, Pennsylvania manufacturing plants fail to comply with the requirements of Part 567, "Certification". We are notifying owners in order to correct the problem. A copy of the letter sent to owners is enclosed for your information.

WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

Fleetwood Enterprises Inc., has become aware of a rear tire pressure rating input error. The Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification Tag was printed with an incorrect rear tire value of 60 pounds per square inch air pressure (psi). The correct rear tire pressure value is 80 psi. Please note that all other values are correct.

To correct this non-compliance, it is necessary to replace the Motor Home Manufacturer Federal Certification Tag and check rear tire pressures as described in the enclosed Recall Service Bulletin #61020.

WHAT SHOULD YOU DO?

Owners of the above mentioned motor homes have been asked to contact a Fleetwood dealer to have the described defective condition remedied. In the event that you are contacted by a customer, please verify eligibility by referring to the serial number range listed in the enclosed Recall Service Bulletin #61020 prior to beginning the repairs. Should a customer have you perform this service, please complete the **Fleetwood Repair Order (form X-SR-042)**.

Once repairs are completed, have the customer sign the **Fleetwood Repair Order** and return it to your National Warranty Processing Center in Decatur, Indiana for payment. You will be reimbursed in accordance with Service Bulletin #61020. Customers will not be charged for these repairs.

If you have one of these vehicles in your inventory, you will be mailed a Safety Recall Notice for that specific motor home. Fleetwood is asking our dealers to make repairs to stock units on dealer lots prior to sale or lease.

Federal Law (Section 154 of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1966) requires that:

If you have received a notice of recall or failure to comply from Fleetwood or any component manufacturer, you must repair or otherwise correct the defects on vehicles remaining in your inventory, according to the notification, before selling or leasing the vehicles. Any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of the notice to the lessee within ten days.

Please review this entire package with your parts and service staff to familiarize them with the step by step procedure and implement the Voluntary Safety Recall Campaign.
