This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

On August 23, 2006, Guide Corporation decided that a noncompliance with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 108 exists in Chevrolet Silverado replacement headlamps (Part No. 16526133 & 16526134) manufactured from January 1, 2006 to July 11, 2006.

These lamps can be identified by a date sticker located on the back of the reflector. The recalled lamps have the date (month - day) 1-1 through 7-11 stamped in the upper left corner of a white sticker located on the back of the reflector (Ref. drawing attached). Further identification should include the "GUIDE" trademark permanently molded into the lens.

Guide is recalling 100 percent of these headlamps. Return of recalled lamps and replacement with remedied lamps, including transportation charges, will be free of charge. Your expeditious cooperation in this matter would be greatly appreciated.
