



Today, customer letters and Service and Warranty Information booklet addendums will be mailed to approximately 190,000 subject vehicle owners, stating that the warranty coverage for the instrument cluster has been extended to 10 years with no mileage limitation

Effective immediately, the Instrument Cluster extended Limited Warranty applies to all conditions that warrant the replacement or repair of the Instrument Cluster under the standard warranty terms and conditions.

If the vehicle has an open campaign for the instrument cluster this campaign must be completed first. If there is no open campaign on VMI and this failure exists, submit a warranty claim utilizing normal warranty claim procedures. Please refer to STAR Tekinfo for applicable damage codes.

CUSTOMER REIMBURSEMENT

If the vehicle has already exceeded the original warranty period and the customer has already paid to have the Instrument Cluster replaced for a reason that would be covered under the extension of the original New Car Warranty, they may be eligible for reimbursement of repair costs by presenting adequate documentation (which should be retained in the customer file for audit purposes). Reimbursement is limited to the amount the repair of the Instrument Cluster would have cost if completed by an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer. The dealer should reimburse the customer and then submit a warranty claim using one of the Instrument cluster replacement damage codes, as found under STAR Tekinfo. Warranty reimbursement for parts and labor should be submitted as a "SUBLET" utilizing the sublet code of "sub". The repair date should be the date that the customer paid for the repair.

Dear Mercedes-Benz Owner:

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of additional benefits that Mercedes-Benz is providing you with respect to your vehicle ownership.


To further support you, Mercedes-Benz will extend the warranty on Model Year 2000-2006 S-Class and CL-Class vehicles with respect to the instrument cluster. The warranty is extended, with respect to the instrument cluster, from 4 years/50,000 miles to 10 years with unlimited miles from the vehicle's warranty start date. This extension of the Basic Limited Warranty coverage applies to the vehicle regardless of ownership. Note: Any repairs under this extended warranty should be performed by an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealership. Standard warranty terms and exclusions apply, including the exclusions with respect to extra expenses, as identified in the Service and Warranty Information Booklet.

Please contact your authorized Mercedes-Benz dealership for assistance or additional information. If your dealer is unable to remedy your situation, please contact us at 1-800-FOR-MERCedes (1-800-367-6372).

Please apply the enclosed warranty extension addendum to the inside back cover of your vehicle's Service and Warranty Information Booklet for future reference.

Reimbursement to Customers for Repairs Performed Prior to Extended Warranty

If you have already <u>paid</u> to have this condition corrected you may be eligible to receive reimbursement.

Requests for reimbursement may include parts, labor, fees and taxes. Reimbursement may be limited to the amount the repair would have cost if completed by an authorized Mercedes-Benz dealer. The following documentation must be presented to your dealer for reimbursement.

Original or clear copy of all receipts, invoices and/or repair orders that show:

- The name and address of the person who paid for the repair.
- . The Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) of the vehicle that was repaired.
- What problem occurred, what repair was done, when it was done and who repaired it.
- The total cost of the repair expense that is being claimed.
- Proof of payment of repair (copy of front and back of cancelled check, or copy of credit card receipt).
- Reimbursement will be made by check from your dealer. If your claim is denied
 you will receive a letter from MBUSA within 60 days of receipt with the reason(s)
 for the denial.

Warranty Coverage Extension (Instrument Cluster)

The following applies to the Instrument This extension of the Mercedes-Benz Cluster for model years 2000-2006 S- and CI -Class vehicles.

New Car Limited Warranty applies to these vehicles regardless of ownership.

The Mercedes-Benz New Car Limited Warranty coverage on the Instrument Cluster is extended to 10 years with unlimited miles from the vehicle's warranty start date.

All of the other warranty terms apply to this extension.
