Subject: 2003-05 Murano Fuel Tank Fitting Voluntary Safety Recall Campaign

Attention – Dealer Principals, Sales, Parts and Service Managers

\*\*\*\*\* Campaign Announcement \*\*\*\*\*

Nissan is conducting a safety recall on approximately 15,000 model year 2005 Nissan Murano vehicles. On some vehicles there is the possibility that a vapor hose fitting attached to the fuel tank may come off. This will result in the malfunction indicator lamp (MIL) in the instrument panel coming on and may result in some fuel leakage. If an ignition source is present, a fire could occur.

To prevent this condition from occurring, Nissan will replace the fuel tank with a new one.

Please note: Model year 2006 vehicles are not affected by this campaign.

Nissan expects to start mailing of Owner Notification letters on March 20, 2006. A Recall Campaign Bulletin and an initial supply of parts will be provided to your dealership prior to this date.
