TO: All Coachmen RV Company Dealers

RE: Compliance Recall 06V-365

Dear Coachmen Dealer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Coachmen RV Company has decided that certain 2007 Spirit of America 23 FKS travel trailers manufactured between June 9, 2006 and September 13, 2006, fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 120, "Tire Selection and Rims for Motor Vehicles other than Passenger Cars".

On affected units, the information provided on the certification and tire information labels denoting the tire size is incorrect. The labels applied to the vehicles show the tire size as ST225/75D15C. The tires installed on these vehicles are ST205/75D15C and are the correct tires for the Gross Axle Weight Rating (GAWR) and Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) ratings of these trailers.

Owners of suspect units will be notified in a letter instructing them to contact their Coachmen dealer to schedule an appointment to have their certification and tire information labels replaced. A copy of this letter is attached for your reference.

If you have an in-stock unit or retail sold unit (your customer or an in-transit owner) where the Coachmen serial number appears in the attached affected unit listing, we ask that you submit a Repair Authorization Request through Coach-Link "Online" requesting replacement labels. Please be sure to reference the recall number. Coachmen will immediately send out to you the required replacement labels. Please also find attached information relating to the preparation and submission of claims for reimbursement.
