We regret to inform you of a safety recall campaign on certain 2007 Eclipse and Eclipse Spyder automatic transmission-equipped vehicles. Do not deliver, wholesale trade, or operate on public or private roadway, any 2007 automatic transmission-equipped Eclipse or Eclipse Spyder vehicle unless inspection and repairs, if needed, are performed as described in SR-06-005, or it is verified that the vehicle is not affected by this recall. This notice is in accordance with Title 49, CFR 573; of the NHTSA regulation, prohibiting the sale or lease of defective vehicles prior to correction of a defect. Safety Recall Bulletin SR-06-005 will be available on the Mitsubishi Dealer Link today. Paper copies of the bulletin are being sent to dealers via overnight mail today, including a list of affected VINs in your inventory as of November 7, 2006.

Affected Vehicles

2007 Mitsubishi Eclipse and Eclipse Spyder equipped with automatic transmission

Check the SuperScreen to verify affected units. Affected vehicles will show <u>C0606KXX</u> as an open campaign.

<u>Purpose</u>

The gear shift key interlock cable may be improperly manufactured on some affected vehicles. This could allow the automatic transmission gear selector lever to be moved out of the park position with the key removed from the ignition switch. If the park brake is not applied, and the gear shift lever is moved out of park, the vehicle may roll and result in a vehicle crash.
