RE: Recall Campaign 06V-294, Re-Notification Request

Dear Mr. Person:

This letter is in response to your request dated November 17, 2008, requesting Hyundai-Kia America Technical Center, Inc. (HATCI), renotify owners involved in safety recall 06V-294, who have not had their vehicles corrected or otherwise accounted for.

Please note that HATCI never received the letter dated November 17, 2008 requesting that we conduct a re-notification on this campaign. We happened to be viewing the NHTSA ODI web site and came across the letter by accident. We have contacted your offices and verified that this letter, while posted to your web site, was never actually mailed to us. This accounts for the reason why we are just now responding to this request.

To update your records, please be advised that of the 32,257 vehicles involved in this campaign:

- 10,356 vehicles have been repaired as of 6/9/09;
- 3,056 vehicles have branded titles (Salvaged, Junk, Dismantled); and
- 24 vehicles have been stolen

As per the requests in your letter, the following is the planned schedule for this re-notification campaign:

1. R.L. Polk began updating the mailing list on June 10, 2009;
2. KMA expects to receive the updated mailing list on or about June 25, 2009;
3. KMA plans to begin mailing owner re-notification letters on July 15, 2009;
4. KMA plans to complete the mailing of owner re-notification letters on July 15, 2009.
