Dear Mr. Sykes:

This is to notify you that the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) has made a determination to deny U.S. Bus Corporation's October 24, 2006 petition for an exemption from the recall requirements of 49 U.S.C. Chapter 301 on the basis that its identified noncompliance with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 111, *Rearview Mirrors*, is inconsequential to motor vehicle safety. A copy of the Federal Register notice explaining the basis for this decision is enclosed for your information.

Since this petition has been denied, you must notify according to 49 U.S.C. 30118 and remedy according to 49 U.S.C. 30120. Pursuant to 49 CFR 573.6(c)(8)(iii), you must submit an amended Noncompliance Information Report to my office no later than five (5) working days from your receipt of this letter. That report shall include the following information: (1) recall population, (2) problem description, (3) remedy, and (4) recall schedule. If a portion of the information which is required to fully describe the recall is unknown, the report must still be submitted on time. The remaining information is to be provided as it becomes available.
