RE: VEHICLE DEFECT OWNER NOTIFICATION, 06V-097

Dear Country Coach Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act, CFR 49, 573.5 and 573.6.

DESCRIPTION OF NONCOMPLIANCE:

Country Coach, Inc. has decided that certain motor homes it manufactured fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 120, *Tire selection and rims for motor vehicles other than passenger*. The noncompliance condition is related to an erroneously assigned recommended cold tire inflation pressure for the rear tires only on the Federal tire label. In some cases, this noncompliance could cause premature rear tire tread wear resulting in a potential tire failure during normal driving, which could result in a crash without prior warning.

Country Coach will issue a replacement Federal tire label reflecting the corrected cold tire inflation pressure for the rear tires. The Rear Axle Weight Rating (RAWR) of these motor homes is 20,000 lbs. The original Federal tire label show a cold tire inflation pressure of 120psi. According to the Manufacturer, the maximum cold tire inflation on a dual application is 110psi. The replacement Federal tire label will have a cold tire inflation pressure of 95psi which supports 23,120 pounds. At the corrected cold tire inflation pressure of 95psi the weight carrying capacity of the tires meets the RAWR. The Federal tire label will be provided at no cost to motor home owners. The labor required to remove and replace the Federal tire label is not expected to exceed one-quarter (1/4) hour.

Please contact Country Coach's customer service department at 1-800-452-8015 to arrange for the shipment of your new Federal tire label. After receiving your labels, you find that you are unable change them yourself, contact your nearest Country Coach dealer to arrange a service appointment. Please present this letter and the enclosed warranty claim to the dealer when you take your motor home in to be serviced. The service facility that does the tag replacement will need the warranty claim for their billing.

If you need assistance in locating your nearest Country Coach dealer, please contact Country Coach's customer service department at 1-800-452-8015. The service department will refer you to a service facility near you. Country Coach has provided all of its dealers with instructions for making the necessary repairs. If your dealer fails to remedy the noncompliance on the agreed upon service date or within three (3) days of the scheduled service date, please contact Country Coach customer service by calling 1-800-452-8015 and ask for the Technical Service Representative handling this recall.

You may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of a problem associated with this recall. For more information regarding this contact Country Coach Inc. Compliance Administration at 1-800-452-8015, extension 8382.

If after contacting both your dealer and Country Coach you are not satisfied that the noncompliance has been remedied within a reasonable time, and at no cost to you, you may wish to contact the National Highway Traffic Safety

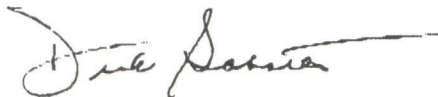
