RE: VEHICLE SAFETY DEFECT OWNER NOTIFICATION, 06V-110

Dear Country Coach Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act, CFR 49, 573.5 and 573.6.

DESCRIPTION OF SAFETY DEFECT:

Country Coach has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2003 Lexa motor homes that it has manufactured. That the exhaust pipe connection to the inlet and outlet side of the muffler may come apart due to the type of muffler clamp currently being used. Should either of these clamps come apart the super-heated exhaust could be expelled into the engine compartment and could cause a fire.

MODELS AFFECTED:

Model Year 2003 Lexa Motor Homes Manufactured from March 2002 through October 2002

VIN Range: 4U7G9EX1631102542 – 4U7G9FX1731103019

See attached listing for specific coach numbers included in this recall.

Country Coach has decided that the repair for this safety defect will be the replacement of the existing band type clamps attaching the muffler to the exhaust pipe and securing the muffler to the tail pipe with guillotine type clamps. If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. Please present this letter and the enclosed warranty claim to the dealer/service facility when you take your motor home in to be serviced. The dealer/service facility that does the repairs will need the warranty claim for billing. The repair and associated parts will be performed and provided at no cost to the owner. The labor required to perform this repair is not expected to exceed three (3.0) hours.

If you no longer own this motor home, please complete and return the Vehicle Owner Reply Card in the self-addressed postage paid envelope included in this package. Federal regulations requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days after receipt of the original notification.

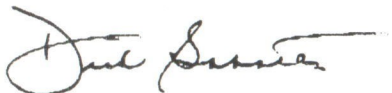
