**Re: Safety Recall Notice; Campaign No. 06V-122;
Bulldog Front Fender Bracket Remedy**

Dear Big Dog Motorcycles Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Big Dog Motorcycles, L.L.C. has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in 2005 Big Dog Motorcycles Bulldog models in which the front fender brackets could fail without warning, allowing the front fender to detach. This condition could lead to a crash.

According to our records, you are the registered owner of a 2005 Big Dog Motorcycles' Bulldog with VIN «VIN», one of the motorcycles subject to this recall. If you have received this notice and are not the owner of the above-mentioned motorcycle, please contact the Big Dog Motorcycles Customer Service Department at 316-267-9121 immediately. Federal regulations require any lessor receiving this letter to forward it to the lessee within 10 days.

What You Should Do

Trail your motorcycle to your Big Dog Motorcycles dealer or service center where the front fender brackets will be replaced. There will be no charge to you.

What We Will Do

Your dealer or service center will replace the front fender brackets with redesigned brackets. This procedure will take approximately one-half hour to perform. Your dealer will be able to provide you with an estimated turnaround time based on scheduling and any other factors that may exist.

If you are not able to obtain the necessary service on your motorcycle, please contact the Big Dog Motorcycles Customer Service Department and we will assist you. The address and telephone number is:

If you previously incurred expenses to remedy the defect that is the subject of this letter, you may be eligible for reimbursement by Big Dog Motorcycles for some or all of those expenses. If you have incurred such expenses, please call Big Dog Motorcycles Customer Service Department collect at 316-267-9121 for full details of the program, including its coverage and limitations.

We appreciate your cooperation and prompt attention to this important matter. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you, and we assure you that we have taken this step as one that is important to your personal safety.
